

- 2. On days when your child will be absent, please call the school before 8:30 AM at 610-351-0234 ext 1, OR email
- attendance@aacms.org to inform us. Include your child's first and last name, their grade, and the reason for their absence. Your child will be marked as "absent unexcused" until the school receives an absentee note.
- 3. Within three days of your child's return to school, a written note which includes your child's name, date of absence, and reason for that absence must be submitted. Without this note, your child absence will remain unexcused. If your child was seen by a doctor, submit the doctor's note within three days of their return.
